- If you live in rented / commissioners accommodation, written permission from the owner will be required. Without this, we are unable to allow you to take the cat.
- The cats and kittens are the responsibility of the Society and are rehomed at our discretion. *We may refuse to rehome an animal without giving a reason.*

### **MSPCA Adoption Conditions**

**Please remove and read carefully.**

1. I am over 18 years old
2. I take full responsibility for the welfare of the animal
3. I understand that the animal has come to the Sanctuary as a stray, unwanted or abandoned and therefore the MSPCA do not know the history of the animal
4. I agree to take the animal in its present state
5. I agree to allow the animal and its accommodation to be inspected by an MSPCA representative at any time
6. I understand that the Society has the right to repossess the animal if not fully satisfied with its welfare or conditions
7. I undertake to obtain veterinary treatment for the animal in case of illness or injury
8. If, during the first 7 days after leaving the Sanctuary, the animal becomes ill, I agree to contact the Sanctuary (telephone number 851672)
9. I undertake that the animal will not be sold or given into other hands
10. I will inform the MSPCA if, at any time, I lose or am no longer able to keep the animal
11. I understand that if I wish to return the animal to the MSPCA no refund will be made
12. I will not permit the animal to be used for illegal sporting purposes

All we ask is a donation towards our costs for the care, food and veterinary charges.
